What comfort did Stephen
receive?*

Psalm 146:1–3.

*God gives us leaders. What
should we remember about
them?*

1 Peter 2:5–7.

*Peter talks about building.
Whom does he call the
living stones? Who is the
important cornerstone?
(What does that mean?)*

*Jesus is the way. To whom?

Acts 7:59–60.

*Think-about-It Thursday:

*What is your favorite song
of praise? Sing it now!*
