

## Camp Friendship “What to Bring” List

- Bible
  - Shorts
  - Jeans
  - Shirts
  - Sweatshirt
  - Jacket
  - Pajamas
  - Shoes (suitable for walking and running)
  - Swimsuit (2 pc. suits may be worn under a t-shirt)
  - Socks
  - Underclothes
  - Rain gear
  - Towels/washcloths
  - Toothbrush/toothpaste
  - Brush/comb
  - Soap/shampoo
  - Flashlight
  - Sleeping bag/pillow (campers will sleep in bunks)
  - Insect repellent
  - Sunscreen
  - Medicine (w/instructions to give to medical staff)
  - Camera (optional)
  - Book for recreational reading (optional)
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- Try not to overload with too much gear, as campers will be carrying their own.
  - Cabins are not air-conditioned, but can become cool overnight. Be sure to have enough bedding.
  - Be sure all belongings are clearly marked with the camper's name.
  - Personal audio devices with headphones are encouraged. Please do not bring larger devices.
  - There is no need to send any money along with campers.
  - There is no need to send any food, snacks or drinks. They are not permitted in the cabins.
