Things I Need to Know

- Health forms are required for youth & adults attending the retreat. **Make sure you have two copies of the health/liability forms for everyone in your group.** One is to be kept with the adult leader, and one with each participant while they are on campus.
- Remember: the program does not include dinner on Friday evening, so make sure your group eats before arriving at the camp.
- We will be housed in the Wilderness Creek Lodge buildings. These are motel-style rooms with heat/AC – not cabins. There are 4 bunk beds and a bathroom with shower in each room.
- Bedding: Windermere does not provide linens, so have each participant bring a sleeping bag (or blanket), pillow and towels. Please also make sure everyone brings shampoo, soap, toothpaste, etc. These items are included on the “What Do I Bring?” list.

- If your group plans to participate in the Talent Show, make sure you review and sign the covenant and turn it in upon registration at the Camp. Auditions must be performed in the same manner in which they will appear in the talent show. You will be allowed a timeframe of 2 to 3 minutes. Due to the length of the Talent Show, songs will need to be sung in an abbreviated format (2 versus, 1 chorus, etc.). Christian music is preferred.
- This event will include servant event time on Saturday afternoon. Please have everyone bring outdoor appropriate work clothes and shoes (no sandals/flip flops). **If possible, please bring rakes.**
- The Saturday Night Fun Fest will include a bonfire, music, board games, basketball and Nintendo Switch. You are welcome to bring a favorite board game to share!
- Basic directions: Camp Windermere is located nine miles west of Camdenton on State Road AA. Follow Highway 54 for 6 miles to State Road AA. Turn right on AA and follow the Windermere signs and proceed to the Wilderness Creek Auditorium. If you need further direction, the camp web site is www.windermereusa.org.
