### Trinity Loves Collegiates: Campus Crates

Trinity's Board for Youth Ministry is beginning a new effort to support our college students by sending "campus crates" during their academic year. Trinity Congregation is invited to share in this special ministry, reminding our college students that even though they might not be physically here with us on a weekly basis, we are still encouraging them with our prayers and support.

**College Students and Parents:** If you would like to receive (or would like your student to receive) a Campus Crate, please fill out a Google form (printed or online) no later than March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

**Congregation:** If you would like to provide a gift for Campus Crates, please bring items to the Church Lobby by March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019. If you would like to help to assemble and send Campus Crates, please visit with DCE Leah or Youth Board Chair, Sally Beaudean.

**Campus Crate Contents:** Examples for gifts include small items such as Post-It Notes, gift cards for fuel or food, writing utensils, devotional material, microwave popcorn and meals, stress ball, wrapped candies and snacks, decks of cards, bubble wrap, hot chocolate packets, "dollar-store" games and toys for "stress-busters", a personal note of encouragement, etc.

### Imposition of Ashes

"Ash Wednesday" marks the beginning of the solemn season of the Church year known as Lent. Again this year, we will offer the imposition of ashes to any worshipers who desire to participate. The ashes are applied in the shape of a cross on a person's forehead. As he administers the ashes, the pastor will say, "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return." This is an outward symbol of contrition, while at the same time knowing that all believers in Christ are washed clean and forgiven in the waters of Holy Baptism. If you would like to participate, the pastors will be in the front of the sanctuary 20 minutes prior to both the 4:00 and 6:30 pm services.

### Stuffed Animals for Children in Crisis



This year, Trinity Lutheran Church will be collecting stuffed animals that **First Responders** will give to children during crisis events. In particular, Trinity is asking you to contribute stuffed lambs and chicks. *(The lamb reminds us that Jesus is the Lamb of God as well as our Good Shepherd.
