The Men's Club will have its regular monthly meeting at 7:00 pm on Wednesday October 17th in the Fellowship Hall.



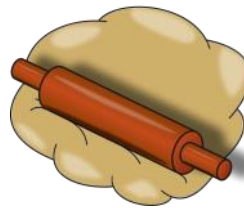


