

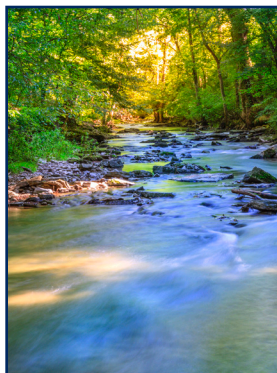

## Boar's Head Festival

DECEMBER 4, 2016 | \$55 PER PERSON

The colorful Boar's Head ceremony became part of the Christmas celebration in the great manor houses of the Middle Ages, but had its roots in pagan times when the boar was the first dish served at a Roman feast. The Church endowed the custom with symbolic Christian meaning and elevated it to the service of God, enriching the lives of all it touched. Sponsored by the Lord of the Manor, the ceremony became a service of praise to Jesus Christ, Lord of the Universe and Redeemer of the World.

"Peace Lutheran Church brings this ancient tradition to South St. Louis, adding voices, music and drama to our prayer that it will be an offering of praise to the One whose birth we celebrate and a witness to the joy we share in our salvation through Him. We offer the Christmas message told through the Boar's Head Festival as our gift through Christ to the South County community."

We will depart from the South side of mall (near the Farmer's Market location) at 2:00 PM. We will stop for a meal at Bob Evans on the way up on your own. A reception with home-baked cookies, wassail, punch and coffee will be available after the performance which should last about one hour and 15 minutes. You can have your picture taken with cast members at that time if you choose.

In this show, Archie and the guys at the loading dock need to learn computer skills at work or they will lose their jobs. Join Edith, the Neighborhood Association, Mike and Gloria, the Jeffersons and other characters to discover who stole Archie's identity. ## Special Gardens and Galleries

JUNE 16, 2017 | \$85 PER PERSON

This tour, led by Linda Koenig, takes us to gorgeous locations that people would otherwise never know to visit. These include the City of St. Louis City Garden, The St. Louis University Art Museum where we can view the marvelous collection of Chihuly glass, old masters, and the Western Jesuit Mission Collection, among others. We will visit the new Gateway Geyser and Arch overlook across the Mississippi River where we will see the St. Louis skyline from a different perspective. After lunch at the GRBIC, a beautiful Bosnian restaurant in the old Bailey's Farm Dairy where the restored interior of European folk art is truly outstanding, as is the food, we will visit the healing garden atop the 8th floor of St. Louis Children's Hospital. Then view the new Maya Lin fountain at the Washington University Medical School, and finally on to the beautiful gardens of Tower Grove Park. Lunch, which is included, will be beef goulash served over spatzle, house salad, fresh bread, beverage and dessert.
