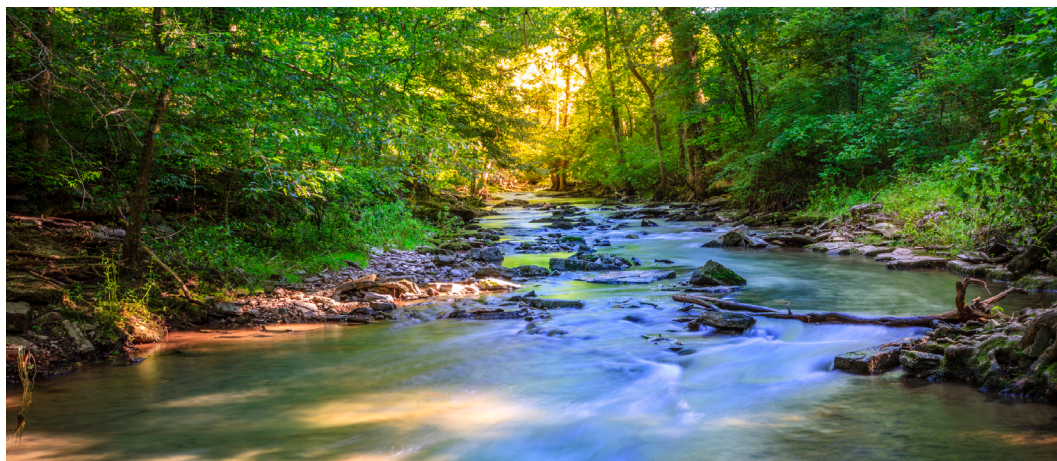

DAY 1

Today we join our fellow Trinity Travelers and journey into Kentucky. Our first stop will be in Hopkinsville, Kentucky, to visit the Pennyroyal Museum, a classic building where many features remain untouched including columns that have stood for almost 100 years. After lunch, we continue to Fairview, Kentucky, to visit the Jefferson Davis Historical Park. This site is a memorial to the Kentuckian best known as President of the Confederacy during the Civil War. Our journey today continues to Bowling Green, Kentucky, where we will overnight.

DAY 2

After an included breakfast at the hotel, most of today will be spent at the Corvette campus. Since 1953 the Corvette has been America's sports car. The Museum was established with the mission of celebrating the invention of the Corvette. After an orientation and a short film, tour the museum at your own pace viewing interactive displays featuring mint condition Corvettes. After lunch at the Corvette Complex, we will tour the Assembly plant where you are up close to the world-famous sports car. We then travel on to Danville, KY, our overnight stop.

DAY 3

After an included breakfast at the hotel, we will see Constitution Square Historic Site in Danville, which was the birthplace of Kentucky's statehood. Several buildings replicate those built to administer to the growing territory. We then drive to Harrodsburg, the home of the Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill, the largest National Historic Landmark in Kentucky and home to the country's largest private

collection of original 19th century buildings. Here, we will enjoy a guided tour of the Historic Centre, The Farm and lunch. In early afternoon, we will continue our Kentucky journey to Berea. There will be time to explore this unique and quaint town. Overnight will be in Berea.

DAY 4

Breakfast is included this morning at the hotel before we drive to Williamstown to visit the Ark Encounter. The Ark Encounter features a large wooden replication of Noah's Ark. Handcrafted animals and people along with the beautiful murals will bring this experience to life for you. You will have time to grab a bite to eat at Emzara's Kitchen at the Complex. After our ark encounter, we will travel on to Frankfort, the capital city of Kentucky. Before checking into our hotel for the night, we will see the new Capitol building and Floral Clock, have a guided tour of the old Capitol building and see the Daniel Boone burial site at Frankfort Cemetery.

DAY 5

Breakfast is once again at the hotel before departing for home but only after a stop at Hodgenville to visit Abraham Lincoln Birthplace National Historic Park. There are two sites, the Boyhood Home at Knob Creek and the Memorial Building which enshrines the symbolic birthplace cabin. After lunch in Elizabethtown, we'll head home while visiting with our friends and sharing highlights from the state of Kentucky.
